This fitting is dimmable, For the best dimming range, use with the Lucci LEDlux SKU# 290998 dimmer and adjust the variable resistor at minimum and maximum dimming positions on the dimmer during the installation. This downlight is also compatible with these dimmers: BUSTER+ PUNCH DIM-002 LUMEX Load Smart LT1D450LS; DIGINET LED Smart MEDM; Clipsal 32EPUDM, 32E450UDM, 32E450TM, 31E2RUDM and 32ELEDM; HPM: Cat. 400T The use of non-compatible dimmers may damage your LED downlight and will void your warranty.
